

4Ws for Week 10 (4-10 Mar 2024)

WELCOME (15 minutes)

(If there are first-time guests, begin with a round of introduction and warmly welcome the new visitors.)

Suggested icebreakers:

1. Getting to Know Me (Online):

Number the members from 1 to 4 based on the Zoom screen. Then, have them share as follows, according to their assigned numbers:

- 1) Describe a time when you encountered a faith-related challenge and overcame it.
- 2) Reflect on a Bible story or character that resonates with you and explain why.
- 3) Share a favourite worship song or Bible verse and explain its significance to you.
- 4) What spiritual practices/disciplines do you find most beneficial in your walk with God.

2. Find and Match (Onsite):

Write out Bible verses on sticky notes and their Bible references (e.g., John 3:16) on other sticky notes. Then, paste these sticky notes with Bible verses and Bible references randomly in the room. Divide the Members into teams of four each. Have the teams match the Bible verses with their references. The team with the most correct matches wins the game.

WORSHIP (20 minutes)

(Encourage members to allow the Holy Spirit to minister through them by sharing words, visions, tongues and interpretations of tongues.)

Scripture Passage: Inward Growth

Sermon Title: Hebrews 5:11-14; Galatians 5:16

Introduction

In the physical realm, all of us grow, so also in the spiritual realm, all of us must grow. Spiritually, God's children should advance because:

- A. We are supposed to grow – Growth is natural, and we have to take responsibility for our growth.
- B. We are expected to serve – As we grow, we advance to the point of impacting others.

FCBC offers two avenues of growth:

1. 21 Days of Prayer (11 – 31 Mar)
2. Encounter Weekends

Discovery and Understanding Questions:

Q1. Read Luke 2:52 and Hebrews 5:11-12, and consider what you can learn from these verses.

A1. Jesus grew physically, cognitively, spiritually, and socially, and disciples of Jesus are expected to grow toward maturity.

Q2. Meditate on Mark 10:45 and 1 Peter 4:10, and share.

A2. Jesus was a Servant, and He calls His children, who share His DNA, to serve in the same manner.
