Scripture Passage: Gen 12:1-3, 2 Sam 7:1-3

Sermon Title: Dream On

Introduction

As believers, we must dream a dream for God that is impossible for us to accomplish on our own, apart from God. A godly dream has the following characteristics:

1. They push you beyond limitations.
2. They push you beyond yourself.

Discovery and Understanding Questions:

Q1. Why did God choose to reveal to Abraham and Sarah that they would have a son when they were past childbearing age?

A1. God's intention was to demonstrate that, despite their advanced age making it humanly impossible for them to conceive, with God, all things are possible. A godly dream pushes us beyond our limitations, necessitating faith in God for its fulfillment.

Q2. Why did God tell David that it would be his son, Solomon, who would build the temple and not David? What lessons can we learn from David's dream to build a temple for God?

A2. When we have a dream for God, we may not see it come to fruition in our lifetime but in the generations after us. A godly dream extends beyond ourselves.

Application Questions

Break into smaller groups, share, pray and minister to one another.

Q1. Share what your "impossible" dream for God is.

Q2. How can you turn your dream into reality?

WORKS (15 minutes)

Focus on edification, equipping and evangelism.
