Scripture Passage: Genesis 1:27-28 (NKJV), Mark 4:3-9 (NKJV), John 15:16 (NIVUK)

Sermon Title: Fruitfulness: God's Charge to Us

Introduction

As believers, God commands us to be fruitful disciples. To be fruitful means to be productive and yielding results, essentially signifying multiplication. The Scriptures speak of fruitfulness in terms of both qualitative and quantitative multiplication. Qualitative multiplication involves growth that makes us become more like Christ in our character, and quantitative multiplication pertains to increasing in numbers, whether through offspring or making disciples. To be fruitful, we need to understand our purpose and to set our priorities.

Discovery and Understanding Questions:

Q1. What is the purpose of being fruitful for God?

A1. Being fruitful glorifies God. Just as a farmer sows seeds into the ground with the purpose of producing a harvest, the purpose of those seeds is multiplication. Similarly, God's purpose is for us to multiply our lives. Consider John 15:8, 16 (NIVUK), and Mark 4:8 (NKJV).

Q2. Since we know that our purpose is to be fruitful, why must we make it a priority?

A2. In order to fulfil our purpose to be fruitful, we must make it a priority in our lives. This entails both quantitative and qualitative growth, involving the pruning of fruitless activities and the elimination of sins. As it is written, "every branch that does not bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful" (John 15:2, NIVUK). To align with our divine purpose, we should prioritise our lives to make disciples for God.

Application Questions

Break into smaller groups, share, pray and minister to one another.

Q1. How much has your life changed to become like Christ since you became a believer?

Q2. How can you be fruitful in terms of reaching out to the lost and make disciples?

WORKS (15 minutes)

Focus on edification, equipping and evangelism.

Build momentum for the Celebration of Life (COL) outreach event taking place from 10-26 November.

- a) Start praying for COL.
- b) Get them start a list of their Bests or contacts to invite.
- c) At every CG gathering, pray over these Bests.
- d) Start booking tickets, if you have not done so (do it by faith while working on inviting your Bests).
- e) Identify additional ways to expedite your invitations, such as arranging transportation for your invitees or planning a meal together before going to the show, etc.)
