
Lesson 1 – The Bible is God’s Word, God’s Word is REAL

Objective:


The Bible is a book that records real stories of real people and it is not a fairy tale. Your child will learn to match pictures through coloring or sticking the pictures.

Printable Materials:

1. Bible booklet (Double-sided – see images below).
2. 9 Bible truths sheet (Cut each truth out and apply glue or use double-sided tape on the reverse side)

Parent to say:

“Each square on the Bible craft is an icon representing one Bible truth that we can learn from the Bible. All the stories in the Bible are real; they really happened. All the promises in the Bible are real; they are God’s promises for us to claim.”

Parent to note:


Parent to explain the Bible picture to your child and get him/her to repeat **“The Bible is real and it is not a fairytale.”** for each picture.

E.g. Bible truth #1 – This is a picture of Jesus. Bible tells us that He is the Son of God and this is real, Jesus is the Son of God’. **“The Bible is real and it is not a fairytale.”**

These are the 9 Bible truths to teach:

Use interactive approach and ask your child what he/she can recall or know about these pictures. After you explain each truth, use a double sided tape or glue to let your child stick the corresponding picture to the Bible booklet.

If you do not want to do sticking, you can have your child colour each truth's picture on the "back page of booklet".

<p><u>Bible Truth # 4</u></p> <p>Jesus died on the cross for our sins.</p> 	<p><u>Bible Truth # 5</u></p> <p>Jesus ate with many people on earth.</p> 	<p><u>Bible Truth # 6</u></p> <p>God put Joseph to be in charge of storing grains in Egypt to save God's people from famine.</p> 
<p><u>Bible Truth # 7</u></p> <p>The Church is where we gather to sing praises to God and to learn about God.</p> 	<p><u>Bible Truth # 8</u></p> <p>God is a God of Peace. The peacemakers will be called sons of God. (Matthew 5:9)</p> 	<p><u>Bible Truth # 9</u></p> <p>The cross is a reminder of God's great love for us.</p> 

Prayer

End with a prayer with the child to thank God for giving us the Bible that helps us to know about Him.

Parents, you can pray and bless your child. Or have your child repeat line by line after you.

Lesson 2 – The Bible is God’s Word, God’s Word is a Love Letter

Objective: The Bible is God’s written Word to tell us about His love for us.

Materials Needed:


1. Big size envelope (can be recycled, preferably with a stamp on it)

Printable Materials:

1. Love letters (Double-side print Pg 1 & 2, then cut the paper into 4 separate letters)

Preparation Needed: Love Letters


Step 1

To cut out all the letters.

Craft to do with your child:

<p>Step 1</p>  <p>Give your child 1 envelope and write the word 'Holy Bible' and draw a postage stamp on the front of the envelope.</p>	<p>Step 2</p>  <p>Write the name of your child on the "Bible" envelope flap.</p>
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Your child will collect 4 love letters and put inside the envelope at the end of the game.

Instructions to do the Love Letter activity

1. Parent to teach your child the meaning of the love letter and give him/her God's love letters.
2. After reading and explaining the love verse, parent will give your child a hug and say to him/her **"God loves you"** and then give out the love letter to your child.
3. Your child will collect all four love letters and put them into 'Bible' envelope.
4. The following are the 4 paraphrased Bible verses which tell about God's love and how you can explain to your child.

Love letter #1 - Romans 8:38-39

Nothing will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Parent to say: "When we are good (parent to pretend to be a child), **God loves you.** When we do naughty things (parent pretends to snatch toy), **God loves you.** When we are sick and has to see doctor, take medicine and sleep, **God loves you.** When daddy canes us and we are punished, **God loves you.** When we travel far away, **God loves you.** Child, nothing can separate us from the love of God. His love is the same all the time. He loves us wherever we are. **(Hug your child and say "God loves you")**

Love letter #2 - Psalm 89:28

I (God) will keep you forever with My lovingkindness and My covenant.

Parent to say: "This love verse is the same as the first one. It describes how our names are written in God's little book of life and each time we pray to God; He remembers that our name is in His book of life. And God is always kind to those who belong to Him" **(Hug your child and say "God loves you")**

Love letter #3 - 1 John 4:10

God loves us and sent His Son Jesus to forgive our sins.

Parent to say: "When we are naughty and are sorry, Jesus paid the price, **God will forgive our sins.** When we are stubborn and are sorry, Jesus paid the price, **God will forgive our sins.** When we tell a lie and are sorry, Jesus paid the price, **God will forgive our sins.** When we are unkind and are sorry, Jesus paid the price, **God will forgive our sins.** When we say mean words and are sorry, Jesus paid the price, **God will forgive our sins.** **(Hug your child and say "God loves you")**

Love letter #4 - John 3:16

Replace "world" with "me"; "whoever" with "I".

For God so loved the world (me), that He gave His only Son, that whoever (I) believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

Lesson 3 – The Bible is God’s Word, God’s Word is the Light to His Way

Objective: God’s Word is a lamp for my feet and a light for my path. I must hide God’s word in my heart so that I will not sin against God.

Psalms 119:105 (NIV) “Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.”

Start this week’s activity by getting your child to make their own craft - ‘**Heart Pouch**’ with his/her name written on it.




Materials Needed:

1. Red Colour A4 paper (preferably)
2. Ribbon
3. Sticky tapes
4. Hole punchers
5. Scissors
6. 4 wisdom verses, pre-written on sticky note pads or normal note pads

Preparation Needed:


Pre-folding of Heart Pouch

<p><u>Step 1</u></p> <p>Prepare 4 wisdom verses by writing the verses on the note pads.</p>	<p><u>Step 2</u></p>  <p>Fold A4 paper vertically into half.</p>
<p><u>Step 3</u></p>  <p>Draw half a heart at the top of the paper and cut it out.</p>	<p><u>Step 4</u></p>  <p>Open up the paper. Fold the bottom edge of the paper towards the “middle of the heart”.</p>
<p><u>Step 6</u></p>  <p>Fold bottom corner of each side towards the middle line.</p>	<p><u>Step 7</u></p>  <p>Fold the flap down as shown.</p>

Step 8

Punch 2 holes at the top of the heart as shown above.




Craft to do with your child:

Step 1



Give your child pre-folded heart. Guide him/her to paste double sided tape onto the flap.

Step 2



Using sticky tape, guide your child to tape the 2 extra flaps down.

Step 3



Guide your child to thread the ribbon through the holes. Tie both ends with a knot.

Step 4



Guide your child to write "Psalm 119:11" at the front of the pocket.

Step 5



Write your child's name on the other side of the heart.

Your child will hang the 'Heart Pouch' on their neck before setting out to play the game.

Props and Visual Aids Needed:

1. Torchlights
2. 4 wisdom verses

Instructions to play the wisdom game:

1. **You must let your child know that you are going to switch off some of the room lights before you play the game. Assure him/her that you are around and it's safe. Do one demo first to let your child experience the darkness level.**
2. Decide the **4** corners of the room to be the wisdom corners and put the **4** wisdom verses at the corners. (Do this before the walk with child begins.)
3. Parent to lead your child to walk one round the room before collecting the wisdom words from each wisdom corner. Parent to switch on torchlight and shine on the floor for your child to follow and walk. Have the Christian instrumental music played at the background while walking.
4. At each wisdom corner, parent to read out wisdom verse to your child, do an "air" hi-five your child and then give the wisdom verse to your child.
5. Guide your child to put each wisdom verse into his/her "Heart pouch".

The 4 paraphrased Bible verses that tell about God's Word giving us wisdom to show us His ways.

Wisdom #1 - Proverbs 4:5

Get wisdom, get understanding; do not forget God's Word.

Wisdom #2 - Psalm 119:105

Your Word is a lamp for my feet and a light for my path.

Wisdom #3 - Proverbs 6:23

God's commandment is a lamp and His teaching is light.

Wisdom #4 - Ecclesiastes 2:13

Wisdom is better than foolishness, just as light is better than darkness.

Prayer

End with a prayer with the child to thank God for His Word that is a lamp for our feet and a light for our path. Pray that the child and yourself will hide God's word in your hearts so that you will not sin against God.

Parents, you can pray and bless your child. Or have your child repeat line by line after you.

Lesson 4 – The Bible is God’s Word, God’s Word is a Treasure

Objective: God’s Word is a treasure, more precious and more desirable than silver or gold. We are to look for it like hidden treasure. It is perfect and flawless like refined gold. Success and prosperity means to have the Word of God in my heart!

Start by helping your child make his/her “Treasure Chest” with his/her name written on it.

Materials Needed:

1. A box (can be a cake box or recycle gift box, preferably 5”x4”x3”)

Printable Materials:

1. Pictures of sides of treasure chest x 3 units (adjust the pictures according to the size of your box before printing)
2. 4 memory verses

Craft to do with your child:

<p><u>Step 1</u></p>  <p>Prepare 1 box for your child.</p>	<p><u>Step 2</u></p>  <p>Front Top</p> <p>Guide your child to create a treasure chest by sticking the pictures of the sides of a treasure chest to the box using glue or double-sided tape. Stick the “front” and top of the chest first.</p>
<p><u>Step 3</u></p>  <p>Stick the “back” of treasure chest on the box.</p>	<p><u>Step 4</u></p>  <p>Write your child’s name at the top of the box.</p>

Your child will bring the “**Treasure Chest**” along to the various Treasure points to collect 4 Treasure verses and put them inside the “Treasure Chest”.

4 paraphrased Treasure Verses from the Bible that highlight the value of God's Word to our lives.

Treasure #1 - Proverbs 8:11

The Word of God is very precious.

Treasure #2 - Psalm 119:127

I love God's commands.

Treasure #3 - Psalm 12:6

God's Word is without mistakes.

Treasure #4 - Proverbs 2:4

God's Word is like a hidden treasure.

Instructions to play the Treasure game:

1. Hide all the 4 Treasure verses in 4 different parts of the house. Try to hide each of them like a treasure.
2. Parent to wait for child to find God's Treasure verses.
3. When each Treasure verse is found, parent will explain what the verse means and how it applies to their lives.
4. Guide your child to put these Treasure verses into their 'Treasure Chest'.
5. Continue to find all the 4 Treasure verses.

Prayer

End with a prayer with the child to thank God for His Word and that they are like treasures more precious than anything else for you. Pray that you and your child will hide God's Word in your hearts.

Parents, you can pray and bless your child. Or have your child repeat line by line after you.

Lesson 5 - The Bible is God's Word, God's Word is Food for our Spirit Man

Objective: God's Word is our daily bread. We do not live by bread alone for our physical bodies but also by the Word of God for our spiritual bodies. And that God's Word tastes so good, like honey from the honey comb.

Matthew 4:4 (NIV) "... Man shall not live by bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God."

Printable Materials:

1. 4 memory verses

Materials Needed:

1. Plastic Cup – 12oz
2. "God's Word is sweet as honey" picture
3. Ribbon – 40cm
4. Hole puncher

Preparation Needed:

<p><u>Step 1</u></p> <p>Print out the memory verses, then cut them into individual pieces.</p>	<p><u>Step 2</u></p>  <p>Punch 2 holes on the top of the cup. Then, tie a string through the holes to form a handle for the cup.</p>
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Craft to do with your child:

<p><u>Step 1</u></p>  <p>Give your child a yellow plastic cup. Guide him/her to paste "God's Word is sweet as honey" sticker label on the cup.</p>	<p><u>Step 2</u></p>  <p>Guide your child to thread the ribbon through the hole. Tie each ends with a knot.</p>
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Step 3

Write your child's name
on the cup.



Your child will collect 4 verses and put inside the cup.

Props and Visual Aids Needed:

1. Organic honey (Normal honey will do too)
2. Bread – to cut into small squares and triangles and put them on a plate, different shape for each bread corner if you like.
3. Plastic gloves (if needed)
4. Spoon – to scoop the honey
5. Four memory verses

Instructions to play the Honey and Bread activity:

1. Assign two corners - one to be the Bread corner and the other will be the Honey corner.
2. Parent to lead your child to either the Bread or Honey corner.
3. At each corner, parent will read out honey or bread verse and explain the meaning of the verses to your child, then give your child either a spoon to dip into honey [honey station] or a piece of bread [bread station] to eat.
4. As your child eat, parent is to say, “God’s Word is my daily bread!” or “God’s Word is sweeter than honey!” “Come and taste the goodness of God’s Word.”

Honey & Bread Corners

Four verses from the Bible that remind them to read [eat] God’s Word every day to build their spirit man, and God’s Word tastes so good - it’s like honey! God’s Word tastes so sweet and it is good for me.”

Honey corner #1 - Psalm 119:103 (NIV)

How sweet are Your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

Parent to say: “Can you tell me what kind of food taste sweet? (*let your child respond and use one food example to interact with him/her*). When you suck a lollipop, how does it make you feel? Do you feel very happy? Do feel like you want to keep sucking the lollipop until you finish the whole thing? Yes, when we taste something sweet, it makes us want to eat more and feel happy. In the same way, when we hear God’s Word and Bible story, it should make you happy and want more.”

Honey corner #2 - Psalm 19:10 (NIV)

...They are sweeter than honey, than honey from the honeycomb.

Parent to say: “Do you know where does honey comes from? It comes from honeybees which go collecting nectar from flowers. Then they slowly digest the nectar to become honey. Do you know honey can be used to make drinks, bake cakes and what else? **(let your child respond)**. Honey is a healthy food and it is good for our body. God’s Word is like honey and it is useful and healthy for our spirit man. God’s Word will help our spirit man grow to become healthier.

Bread corner #1 - Matthew 4:4 (ESV)

Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that comes from the mouth of God.

Parent to say: Do you like to eat bread for breakfast? What kind of bread do you like? Is roti prata or pancake a kind of bread? **(let your child respond)**. Do you take bread daily or every day? If you miss eating bread for one day, how would you feel? **(let your child respond)**. So, when Daddy or Mummy read God’s Word to you every day or tell you a Bible Story or pray with you God’s Word, you are like receiving food to your spirit man every day. We need to feed our spirit man daily, just like we feed our physical man with bread every day.”

Bread corner #2 – Job 23:12 (NIV)

I have not departed from the commands of His lips; I have treasured the Words of His mouth more than my daily bread.

Parent to say: “Just now what did you learn about God’s Word is our daily bread? Well, do you know when your body is very hungry and you see a slice of bread, what will you do? You will take the slice of bread and treasure it and slowly eat the bread and remember to be thankful to God. The Word of God must be something we take daily and we must have a hunger for the Word of God and ask God to feed us daily with His Word.”
