## The Importance of Pretend Play

Through Pretend Play your child will learn by imagining and doing. The process of Pretend Play builds skills in many essential developmental areas – moral development skill of empathy, self esteem; understand the difference between fantasy and reality, power of language, building vocabulary and problem solving.

## Parts of Story with Pretend Play

Below are suggested parts of Noah's Ark story that you can do Pretend Play with your child:

Action		
Get child to make a sad face		
Child to do 'thumbs up'		
Use loud thundering voice		
Help Noah build ark using toy tools		
Wiggle fingers to imitate rain fall		
Hands to flap and 'fly' like a bird		
Arms draw an arch overhead		

The	Memory	<b>Verse</b>			
This	series is	taken	from	Genesis	6:22.

<u>Word</u>	Action	
Noah	Bend and walk like an old man	
Did	Clinched both fists, place them on top of one another	
Everything	Both hands facing the children and do circular movement	
Just as God	Both pointer fingers pointing up	
Commanded him	Right pointer finger takes a request (order) from the mouth and send it forth	
Genesis 6:22	Hands like an open bible
